Gauges whether women in the past year have been tested or screened for the most frequent, fastest growing and/or the most damaging diseases: high blood pressure, cancer, diabetes, and sexually transmitted diseases.

Gauges women's ability to meet their basic needs in the last 12 months in terms of being able to buy the food their family needed and provide adequate shelter.

Gauges women's satisfaction with access to quality healthcare care in general, whether they think pregnant women receive high-quality care, and whether they feel safe walking alone at night.
